

## Town of Barnstable Recreation Division Beach Information



Welcome! Below is a list of the Barnstable Beaches. Click on any of the beaches to see more details, including directions and amenities. A list of Town of Barnstable Beach Rules is on Page 3.

<u>Covell's Beach:</u> A resident/taxpayer only ocean beach in Centerville. An annual resident/taxpayer parking permit is required.

<u>Craigville Beach:</u> A resident and visitor ocean beach in Centerville. Beach parking with a resident/taxpayer parking permit or daily parking pass is required.

<u>Dowses Beach:</u> A resident/taxpayer only beach in Osterville. An annual resident/taxpayer parking permit is required.

<u>Eugenia Fortes Beach:</u> A resident/taxpayer only beach in Hyannis. An annual resident/taxpayer parking permit is required.

<u>Hamblin's Pond:</u> A resident/taxpayer only pond in Marstons Mills. An annual resident/taxpayer parking permit is required.

<u>Hathaway's Pond:</u> A resident and visitor pond in Barnstable. Beach parking with a resident/taxpayer parking permit or daily parking pass is required.

<u>Joshua's Pond:</u> A resident/taxpayer only pond in Marstons Mills. An annual resident/taxpayer parking permit is required.

<u>Kalmus Beach</u>: A resident and visitor ocean beach in Hyannis. Beach parking with a resident/taxpayer parking permit or daily parking pass is required.

<u>Keyes Beach (Sea Street Beach)</u>: A resident and visitor ocean beach in Hyannis. Beach parking with a resident/taxpayer parking permit or daily parking pass is required.

<u>Loop Beach</u>: A resident/taxpayer only beach in Osterville. An annual resident/taxpayer parking permit is required.

Millway Beach: A resident/taxpayer only beach in Barnstable. An annual resident/taxpayer parking permit is required.

<u>Sandy Neck Beach</u>: A resident and visitor ocean beach in Barnstable. Beach parking with a resident/taxpayer parking permit or daily parking pass is required.

<u>Veteran's Beach:</u> A resident and visitor ocean beach in Hyannis. Beach parking with a resident/taxpayer parking permit or daily parking pass is required.

<u>Wequaquet Lake:</u> A resident/taxpayer only lake in Centerville. An annual resident/taxpayer parking permit is required.



## Town of Barnstable Recreation Division Rules & Regulations for Beaches & Parking Permits



The following are found in Chapter 401A of the Town of Barnstable E-Code:

For the safety and enjoyment of all, the following policies and procedures are in effect for all users:

- No littering or solicitation.
- No alcohol, fires or glass containers on the beach or in the parking lot.
- Dogs are not allowed at any time, on any beach/recreation area from May 15 -September 15.
- Swimming is allowed in designated swimming areas only.
- Flotation devices are allowed during onshore breezes only.
- Lifeguards are on duty (where available) from 9:00am 5:00pm everyday starting in late June.
- Restrooms are open from 9:00am 4:30pm.
- Gates open at 9:00am and are locked promptly at 9:00pm. Parking fees are collected from 9:00am 3:45pm. Craigville Beach parking fees are collected from 7:30am 3:45pm (unless otherwise posted).
- Beaches that are staffed (including bathhouses) starting Memorial Day weekend are: Veteran's, Kalmus, Sea Street, Covell's, Craigville and Dowse's. All other locations open in late June.
- Failure to comply with Beach Staff may result in loss of beach privileges, punishment by fines, and/or arrest per Town of Barnstable by-laws.
- No disturbances or other breaches of peace will be tolerated.
- All umbrellas must be secured properly and may not obstruct the lifeguard's view of the water. The use of umbrellas/tents may be suspended by staff if weather conditions merit such action.
- Any person using obscenities, particularly in a threatening manner toward any Town of Barnstable employee, will be asked to leave.
- Drones are prohibited from launching and/or landing on any Town of Barnstable Beach.
- No smoking on any bathing beach or recreation area.
- Resident Parking Permits are required year-round (January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year through December 31st of the current year), at all posted beaches and Town Ways to Water.
